**O R D E R**

**PRESENT : SRI SHAILENDRA KUMAR SINGH, ASJ-IV**

1. Bail petition dated **18/05/2026** for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of above named accused petitioners, who are in judicial custody **since, 08/05/2026** in connection with **Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 68 of 2026**, for the offence *u/s 115(2), 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2) r/w 3(5) BNS, pressed today.*
2. Heard, Ld. Counsel & Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP) appearing on behalf of the petitioners as well as the State.
3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant, **Sanjit Mochi** is that on 06/05/2026 at 07:00 PM, Harikant Ravidas, Manju Devi & their two sons Chandan Ravidas & Mithun Ravidas abused & misbehaved with his wife and father. On protest, they assaulted him and his wife and father with *iron-rod*, due to which, they sustained injury.
4. It has been submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and the petitioners have **no** criminal antecedent. This case has been compromised between the parties and he has filed with permission to compromise the case in lower Court. No public policy has involved in both the case. Petitioners are ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.
5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for regular bail of accused petitioners.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is allegation against petitioner that they along with other co-accused persons have abused & assaulted informant and his family member, due to which, they sustained injuries. Both parties have compromised this case and filed joint compromise petition. Informant produced through video conferencing & two other injured are present before the Court. They accepted factual of compromise and submitted that they sustained injury due to falling down. As per injury report attached with CD, Neelam Devi sustained injury on forearm. Basant Mochi & Sanjit Mochi sustained injury on head. Petitioner has been under judicial custody **since, 08/05/2026**.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, **compromise, period of custody, undergone** prayer of regular bail of on behalf of above named accused petitioners, **are hereby allowed**. Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions **that (a) One of the Bailor shall be family member/close relative, (b) They will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to commit such occurrence in future**. It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioners at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
