1. A petition dated **06/02/2026** for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No. 633 (C) of 2022**, for the alleged have committed offences punishable u/s 498A of IPC & 3/4 DP Act, pressed today. A copy of bail petition has already been served to the I.d. APP.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per complaint petition of **Priyanka Kumari**, is that she got married with Kunal Kumar in the year 2018. At the time of marriage of 11 lakhs were given to her in-laws as gift. Her husband & in-laws started demanding dowry & other household item from her parents. Out of wedlock, one girl child born in April 2022, but her husband & in-laws never came to see them. When she went to workplace of her husband at Katni (MP) her husband misbehaved & thrown out from house. Her husband is having illicit relation with one Sonam Namdev in Katni.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and petitioner has criminal antecedent. Petitioner is quite innocent & committed no offence. No such occurrence has ever been taken place as alleged by the complainant. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. I.d. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State ^{not} opposed the prayer of petitioner for anticipatory bail but conceded the fact that complainant is reluctant [^] to stay with petitioner. Cont'd/.....

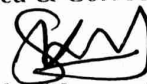

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) has been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is allegation against accused petitioner that he alongwith his parents used to torture complainant for fulfillment of unlawful demand of dowry. Due to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry he drove out his wife from matrimonial house and not maintaining her. During hearing petitioner & complainant were present before the Court. Petitioner is ready & willing to keep and maintain complainant and her daughter. Petitioner has also submitted undertaking to this regard. On contrary, complainant Priyanka Kumari is not willing to live with her husband and submitted that she has filed a divorce case in Patna for taking divorce from husband. She has also made endorsement in the margin of order-sheet to this effect. Despite counseling by this Court complainant is reluctant not to go with her husband.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, prayer of anticipatory bail of above named **petitioner** is **hereby allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Ld. Trial Court **within four weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order**, petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C. (a) **One of the Bailor shall be family member/Close relative & (b) He will co-operate in the trial of this case.** Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
