

1. Bail petition dated **29/05/2026** for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of above named accused petitioner, who is in judicial custody **since, 18/05/2026** in connection with **Ghoswari P.S. Case No. 130 of 2025**, for the offence u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 109(1), 76, 352, 351(2) BNS & 27 Arms Act, *pressed today*.
2. Heard, Ld. Counsel & Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP) appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as the State.
3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant **Rahul Kumar** is that, on 13/10/2025 at 03:30 PM, Mithlesh Yadav & 12 others came to his *Bathan* & started abusing. On protest, they assaulted him and his mother. Mithlesh Yadav, Pappu Yadav & Arvind Yadav also fired bullet on wall of his house.
4. It has been submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and the petitioner has criminal antecedent. The allegation of firing is against Mithlesh Yadav and two others, who are enjoying the privilege of anticipatory bail. The case has been compromised between both parties. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.
5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for regular bail of accused petitioner.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is general & *omnibus* allegation against accused petitioners that they alongwith other co-accused persons have abused & assaulted informant and his mother and also fired the bullets on the wall of informant. **As per FIR and case diary, no one sustained any injury.** Further, from case diary, it also reveals that **no alleged fired cartridges have been recovered from the place of occurrence. Co-accused persons placed at similar situation has already been granted anticipatory bail & regular bail vide order dated 15/12/2025, 21/01/2026 & 18/12/2025, 19/11/2025 passed in ABP No. 1285/2025, 1452/2025 & BP No. 817/2025, 745/2025.**

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, **period of custody & undergone** prayer of regular bail of on behalf of above named accused petitioner, **is hereby allowed.** Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions **that (a) One of the Bailor shall be family member/close relative, (b) They will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to commit such occurrence in future.** It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioner at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
