ORDER

1. Bail petition dated **30/05/2026** for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of above named accused petitioner, who is in judicial custody **since, 27/04/2026** in connection with **Mokama P.S. Case No. 94 of 2026**, for the offence u/s 25(1-B)a, 26, 29 & 35 Arms Act, pressed today.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel & Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP) appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant **Satyam Kumar** is that on 26/02/2026 at about 17:30 PM, he came to know that one person is exhibiting fire-arms & cartridges on social media. With the help of *Chaukidar*, accused was identified as Pavan Kumar @ Pawan Yadav & he was arrested. In his confessional statement, Pavan Kumar accepted his involvement and stated that he has taken this fire-arms from Chanarik Yadav. On the information of Pavan Kumar, the arms & ammunition has been recovered from the house of accused Chanarik Yadav. The arms & ammunition were seized and Pavan Yadav was arrested.

4. It has been submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and the petitioner has **no** criminal antecedent. Petitioner is a labour in NTPC Barh earning member of his family and the family is now at the stage of starvation. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for regular bail of accused petitioner.

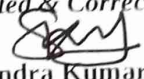

6. Case Diary(CD) & TCR have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that petitioner is named in the FIR. On the confessional statement of co-accused person one loaded *country-made* pistol alongwith 15 cartridges were recovered from the house of petitioner. No any overt-act has been done by petitioner. As per para 98 of CD, petitioner has **no** criminal antecedent. Petitioner has been under judicial custody since, 27/04/2026. Co-accused who was exhibiting fire-arms of social media has been **granted bail vide order dated 25/04/2026 passed in BP No. 204/2026 by this Court.** As per para-52 of supplementary CD, investigation against petitioner is completed.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, **clean antecedent, period of custody & undergone** prayer of regular bail of on behalf of above named accused petitioner, is **hereby allowed.** Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions **that (a) One of the Bailor shall be family member/close relative, (b) He will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to such type of occurrence in future.** Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court. Observations/findings made above is only restricted for disposal of this bail petition and it will not effect the merit of case during investigation, enquiry & trial case. Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
