ORDER

1. A petition dated **03/06/2026**, for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named **sole** petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Athmalgola P.S Case No. 199 of 2025**, for the alleged have committed offenses punishable u/s 103(1), 61(2) BNS & 27 Arms Act, *pressed today*.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of the **informant, Sanju Devi** is that on 05/06/2025 at 05:30 PM her husband Jitendra Kumar was standing on road. In the meantime, Rahul Kumar & 7 others armed with pistol and other deadly weapon came and started abusing. On the direction of Lakhan Singh, Jitesh Kumar and Rahul Kumar fired bullet on her husband, due to which, he died, on the spot.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and he has **no** criminal antecedent. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. No such occurrence has ever been taken place as alleged by the informant. The petitioner and entire family members and relative have been made accused in this case due to land dispute. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State vehemently opposed the prayer of petitioner for anticipatory bail and submitted that allegation against him is serious in nature. **Cont'd/-...**

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R.) & case diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is **direct & specific** allegation against petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused persons have **murdered husband of informant by giving fire-arms injury**. Informant in re-statement and other witnesses at paras 9, 10 & 11 of case diary have **supported the version of FIR**. At para-36 of case diary, ASP Barh in his supervision note has **found case to be true against petitioner for offences punishable u/s 103(1)/61(2) BNS. Investigation of this case is still going on.** If petitioner is granted bail there is possibility of threatening the witnesses and delaying proceeding of this case. It is pertinent to mention here that date of birth of petitioner, as per document attached with bail petition is on 12/06/2008 and date of occurrence is 05/06/2025, hence, petitioner seems to be a **child in conflict with law (C.C.L.)** Regular bail of one of the co-accused persons namely, **Lakhan Yadav** has already been rejected vide order dated 25/08/2025 passed in BP No. **560 of 2025**. **ABP of other co-accused persons placed at similar footing has already been rejected** vide order dated 03/11/2025, 26/11/2025 & 25/03/2026 passed in ABP No. 1153/2025 & 1173/2025 & 183/2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **nature, gravity and seriousness of accusation**, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner is hereby **Rejected**. Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
