ORDER

1. A petition dated **15/06/2026**, for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named sole petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Bakhtiyarpur P.S Case No. 308 of 2025**, for the alleged have committed offenses punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2) r/w 3(5) BNS, pressed today.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant, **Rajkumar** is that on 25/06/2025 at 09:35 AM, Kamlesh Kumar took him in the field near *Belthan*, where Rajdhani Mochi & others were present Rajdhani Mochi assaulted him with *lathi*, due to which, his head broke. Other persons also assaulted with leg & fist Kamlesh Kumar snatched Rs. 2,000/- from his pocket.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and he **has criminal antecedent**. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Actually the petitioner's son *namely*, Kamlesh Kumar is student of intermediate & the other son of the petitioner resides outside & works in TVS bike company but even then they have been roped. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that there is serious allegation against petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused persons have assaulted informant & snatched Rs. 2,000/- from him, due to assault by Rajdhani Mochi head of informant broke.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R.) & case diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is **direct & specific** allegation against accused petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused persons have assaulted informant & snatched Rs. 2,000/- from him. Due to assault by petitioner, **head of informant broke**. As per injury report attached with CD, informant has sustained two injuries, one of which is **on the vital part of the body i.e. temporal & parietal region of head**. Informant in his restatement and other witnesses **at different paras of case diary have supported the version of FIR**. As per para-3 of bail petition, petitioner has **one criminal antecedent**. Investigation is still going on, new facts may emerge.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **nature, gravity, seriousness & criminal antecedent of accusation**, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner is hereby **Rejected**. It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioner at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
