1. Anticipatory Bail petition dated **17/06/2026** for grant of Anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named **sole** accused petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 89 of 2025**, for the offence **u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2) BNS & 27 Arms Act**, *pressed today*. A copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. APP.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel & Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP) appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as the State.

3. Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of informant **Munna Rai @ Ranjit Ray** is that, on 28/02/2025 at 05:30 PM, he was returning on Motorcycle from Pooja Hotel, on the way Arun Ray and eight others persons stopped him and started abusing & firing on him, due to which he sustained injury on his buttock. On *Hulla*, nearby people came and took him to PHC, Bakhtiyarpur

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and he has criminal antecedent. The petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. No empty cartridges has been found recovered at the alleged place of occurrence. No injury sustained by fire-arms as stated in FIR. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) has been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is general & *omnibus* allegation against accused petitioners that they have abused & fired bullet on him, due to which, he sustained injury on his buttock. As per injury report attached with case diary "lacerated wound on both side of buttock by hard blunt object (simple in nature) has been found on the person of informant. No fire arm injury is mentioned in the injury report. **Other co-accused persons placed at similar footing has already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 12/06/2025 passed in ABP No. 343/2025 on the basis of compromise.**

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, prayer of anticipatory bail of above named **sole** petitioner is *hereby allowed*. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Ld. Trial Court ***within four weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order***, petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) BNSS. **Further condition that (a) One of the Bailor shall be family member, (b) He will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to commit such occurrence in future.** Observations/findings made above is only restricted for disposal of this bail petition and it will not effect the merit of case during investigation, enquiry & trial case. Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
