ORDER

1. Bail petition dated 20/06/2026 for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of above named accused petitioner, who is in judicial custody since, 26/05/2026 in connection with **Salimpur P.S. Case No. 29 of 2020**, for the offence u/s 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504, 354, 307, 506 IPC, pressed today.

2. Heard, L.d. Counsel & L.d. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP) appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant **Lal Bahadur Mahto** is that 03/02/2020, at 12:30 PM, he along with his wife were working in Field. In the meantime, Bhola Sharma along with seven other persons came and started abusing his wife and Bhola Sharma tried to molest his wife. When he protested, all accused persons assaulted him with *farsa, lathi & danda*, due to which, he sustained injury on head. Laxman Sharma assaulted his son with iron rod, due to which, he sustained injury.

4. It has been submitted by the L.d. Counsel for the petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before L.d. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and the petitioner has **no** criminal antecedent. The petitioner is supervisor in a private company at Delhi. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for regular bail of accused petitioner.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is general & omnibus allegation against accused petitioners that he alongwith other accused persons have abused & assaulted informant and his son, due to which, they sustained injury on head. There is also allegation accused petitioner that he has caught hand of wife of informant. As per para-69 of CD, information submitted he was referred to PMCH/NMCH but he & his son got treatment in village itself and did not went to NMCH, which suggests that injury was not so serious. Investigation has been completed & police has submitted charge-sheet against the petitioner. Hence, no custodial interrogation is required. Co-accused persons have **already been allowed regular bail vide order dated 19/06/2026 passed in BP No. 317 & 319 of 2026**. Petitioners have been under judicial custody since, 26/05/2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, **period of custody & undergone** prayer of regular bail of on behalf of above named accused petitioner, **is hereby allowed**. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand)** each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions that (a) **One of the Bailor shall be family member/close relative,** (b) ^{He is} ~~They~~ **will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to commit such occurrence in future.** It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioner at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
