**ORDER**

1. A petition dated **29/07/2025**, for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 65 of 2025**, for the alleged have committed offenses punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 74, 324(4), 352(2), 351(2), 118(2), 303(2), r/w 3(5) BNS, pressed today.
2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.
3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of informant **Vishundev Sahni** is that, on 08/06/2025 at 05:30 AM, Nitish Paswan came on the fish of shop of his *daughter-in-law*, Rekha Devi and started abusing her. On protest Nitish Paswan dragged her by pulling hair. In the meantime, family members of Nitish Kumar also came and started assaulting his daughter-in-law with *lathi & danda*. When his grandson went for rescue, they also assaulted him, due to which, he sustained injury. Nitish Kumar threw his fish from her shop here & there, due to which, he sustained loss of Rs. 1,000/-. Nitish Kumar also assaulted his daughter-in-law, Rekha Devi with knife, due to which, she sustained injury on back. Nitish Paswan snatched gold *jitia* from neck of Rekha Devi.
4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and **he has criminal antecedent**. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. According to FIR, injury is not vital part of body. The petitioner and prosecution parties both are next door neighbour. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.
5. Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State vehemently opposed the prayer of petitioner for anticipatory bail and submitted there is serious allegation against the petitioner. **Cont'd/-...**

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R.) & case diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is **direct & specific** allegation against accused petitioner that he has thrashed daughter-in-law of informant on the ground by pulling hair & assaulted her with knife, due to which, she sustained injury on the back of chest. As per injury report attached with CD, daughter-in-law of informant (Rekha Devi) sustained injury **in the back of chest by sharp object**. As per para 11 of CD, **petitioner has criminal antecedent**. Informant in his re-statement & other witnesses at **different paras of case diary have supported the version of FIR**. Investigation is still going on, new facts may emerge.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **criminal antecedent, nature, gravity and seriousness of accusation**, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. *Accordingly*, prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of above named of **sole** petitioner is hereby **Rejected**. Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
