ORDER

1. A petition dated **03/07/2026**, for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named **sole** petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Barh P.S Case No. 337 of 2022**, for the alleged have committed offenses punishable u/s 379, 467, 468, 406 r/w 34 IPC, *pressed today*.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per written report of **informant, Major Guru Charan Singh Bhullar, AGM (Admin) of BSCPL Infrastructure Limited**, is that Dozer Operator, Bhola Rai alongwith night-guard Vikash Kumar used to misappropriate dozer log-books took away about 200 liters of diesel per days by illegal means. In surprise check, it was confirmed that they were doing this for several days. By the act of accused persons, company sustained loss of lakhs of rupees.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and he has **no** criminal antecedent. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is no specific allegation is made against the petitioner and also no information or warning has been given to the petitioner regarding such act. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that he alongwith other co-accused *namely*, Bhola Rai used to take out 200 liters of diesel from the dozer of company of informant by illegal means, due to which, company sustained loss of lakhs of rupees.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R.) & case diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is **direct & specific** allegation against accused petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused *namely*, Bhola Rai used to take out 200 liters of diesel from the dozer of company by illegal means, **due to which, company sustained loss of lakhs of rupees**. When petitioner was called by company, **he fled-away and left the job**. Act done by petitioner is serious in nature. Informant in his re-statement and other witnesses at different paras of case diary have **supported the version of FIR**. Investigation is still going on, new facts may emerge.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **nature, gravity, seriousness of accusation**, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. *Accordingly*, prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner is hereby **Rejected**. It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioner at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
