**Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 06/2026**

Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant 1. Ms. Pooja @ Pooja Kishore along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Chandrakant Mishra . Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case- 734/2025 for offenses U/S 316(2), 316(5), 318(4), 132, 351(2) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that Pritam Kumar states that Ms. Pooja used indecent language in the office and sent unsolicited messages in the office attendance group. On 09.09.2025, a confidential file was asked to produce but Ms. Pooja took away the file. She was asked to return the file but Ms. Pooja left the office campus. DCLR asked the produced the file then, after many difficulties the file was obtained from Ms. Pooja. As per the informant on earlier occasion also Ms. Pooja had tried to tarnish the image of office which was complained by the staffs even after that pressure was created to implicate employees in false cases.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicant has not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicant has no criminal history. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is no possibility of fleeing or tampering with the evidence. Nothing is recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The applicant is ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. Both parties have compromised the dispute. The said file has been produced by the petitioner. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has

opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case record and case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case recored and the case diary. The petitioner is a lady. As per the case of prosecution the petitioner was asked to submit a confidential file but she did not put the file in time and threatened other employees to implicate in false case. It is submitted that the said file was later submitted by the petitioner. It is submitted both sides have compromised the dispute amicably.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner Ms. Pooja @ Pooja Kishore on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
