**ORDER**

**Dated: 12.03.2026**

This bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Deepak Kumar** in connection with **Kadirganj P.S. Case No.35/2025** for the offence **U/s 309(4) of the BNS**, which is pending in the court of the ACJM, Masaurhi is being pressed today and heard.

The case of the prosecution as per the written information given by Sujit Kumar is that on 25.02.2025 while he was returning to home after his job at about 6.35 hrs. reached at Radha Choumuhana More, three persons riding over Pulsar 220 motorcycle came towards Harla and dashed his bi-cycle and assaulted him and snatched his mobile VIVO Y 56 under threat of dire consequences and fled away towards Dhanarua side and accordingly, this FIR instituted.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has not moved earlier his any bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court. Petitioner has got three criminal antecedent prior to this case. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.01.2026. Petitioner is innocent and has not committed alleged offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. The Petitioner's name has come on the basis of the confessional statement of the co-accused Jitendra Kumar. Seized mobile has not been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The co-accused Jitendra Kumar has already been granted bail vide B.P. No. 161/2025, dated 09.07.2025. Petitioner undertakes to cooperate during investigation. Petitioner is ready to furnish sufficient sureties.

On the other hand the learned Addl. P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard the argument of both sides and perused the case record as well as the case diary. Petitioner has got one criminal antecedent vide Gaurichak P.S. Case No. 259/2025 mentioned in the para 78 of the case diary. The name of the petitioner has been surfaced in the confessional statement of the co-accused Jitendra Kumar, who stated that petitioner used to send him the photographs of mobile of theft for the purpose of sale. On the basis of the statement of Jitendra Kumar, the house of the petitioner Jitendra Kumar was raided and he was caught with illegal weapons for which Gaurichak P.S. Case No. 259/2025 under arms act was registered. As per para 3 of the bail petition there are three criminal antecedent of the petitioner. Para 48 of the CD shows that a motorcycle was also seized from the other room of the house of Deepak Kumar, which was a black coloured pulsar 220 motorcycle and in this case also as reflected by para-49, a black colour pulsar motorcycle was used by accused. The case is still under investigation against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail, hence his prayer for regular bail is hereby **rejected**. Accordingly, this bail petition is hereby disposed off.
