Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Rakesh Kumar @ Pintu Singh along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Gautam Kumar. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioner is named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 28/2026 for offenses U/S 109, 118(2), 126(2), 3(5) of BNS and 27 Arms Act. The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Santosh Kumar stated that on 15.01.2026 at around 06:30 PM in the evening, His son Ritik Roshan and Bittu Kumar of his own village went to see his farm on his bike. At around 06:45 PM, Bittu Kumar and Ritik Roshan told him that on the way while returning from his farm. Pappu Kumar , Nand Kumar, Shiv Kumar, Pintu Singh, Vipin Kumar, Haripraksh Kumar and three, four unknown persons were consuming drugs. All the above mentioned persons asked his son and another friends where are you coming from. His son and his friend said that he is coming after seeing his wheat field. After that his son said that you all should consume drugs. After that, his son and his friend got on their bike, and Pappu Kumar told Shiv Kumar to shoot them both. Shiv Kumar then took out his weapon from his waist and fired at his son and his friend with the intention of killing them. The bullet passed through his son's waist from the left side and lodged in his friend Bittu Kumar's spine. After that, Awadhesh took him to a doctor on his own bike for treatment. Since the doctor was not available there, he went to the sub divisonal hospital in Masuaarhi. From there they took his son and his friend in an ambulance to Hi-tech hospitial Danapur, Patna. From there, he was taken to AIIMS Patna for better treatment. He is currently admitted there.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants has not filed any anticipatory bail application or regular petition before Honourable High Court. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents. The petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner was at his home in Masaurhi which can be verified by CCTV footage also. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. No incriminating articles has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners the petitioner has been

falsely implicated due to village politics. The petitioner undertakes to abide by all the condition by the court and is ready to give reasonable surity for his bail. The petitioner has been falsely implicated due to village politics. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case record has been called for and is received. Perused case diary and case record. As per the case of prosecution petitioner and co-accused persons surrounded the injured persons Ritik Raushan and Bittu Kumar. On the order of co-accused Pappu Kumar the accused Shiv Kumar fired a bullet which went through the waist of Ritik Raushan and hit spine of Bittu Kumar. The witnesses in the case diary para 8, 9, 10 (Injured Bittu Kumar) and 11 (Ritik Raushan) the witnesses have supported the case of prosecution. As per para 17 of the case diary empty cartridges have recovered from the place of occurrence. The petitioner is named accused of the F.I.R. Case is still under investigation.

Considering the above facts, circumstances, and nature of the case this court is not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner Rakesh Kumar @ Pintu Singh on anticipatory bail at this stage. Therefore, the prayer of anticipatory bail of the above named accused petitioner is rejected. The anticipatory bail petition of the above named accused is dismissed.
