Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant 1. Mantosh Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioners Shri Sudip Kumar Bhardwaj. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi(Lahsuna) P.S Case-187/2026 for offenses U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 74, 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Santosh Kumar states that on 05-03-2026, at around 7 pm, he was sitting with some people in the garden of his village, when suddenly his brother Mantosh Kumar came to him abusing me. When he stopped him from abusing, his brother took a rod and suddenly hit him on the head, due to which his head got filled with blood and he fell on the ground. Hearing this incident, his wife started crying and screaming. When she came to his rescue, his wife was also assaulted. Other family members immediately took him to the subdivisional hospital in Masaudhi for treatment, and he was later referred to PMCH, Patna for better treatment

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The applicants are ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case Diary has been called for which is received. Perused the case record and case diary. The informant and petitioners are own brothers. As per para 76 of the case diary injury report of injured Santosh Kumar is on record. Which

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shows that simple nature injury was caused to him. As per para 64 of the case diary the petitioner has no criminal antecedents.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner 1. Mantosh Kumar on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Lower Court within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two sureties of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Lower Court.
