Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Putul Devi 2. Mithun Kumar, S/O- Bangali Mahto 3. Priyanka Kumari 3. Bangali Mahato 6. Rohit Kumar 7. Mithun Kumar, S/O- Sunil Sahani along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Vishwanath Prasad Yadav. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 322/2025 for offenses U/S 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 108, 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that the informant Vishundev Kewat states that his son Jitendra Kumar alias Mangal, who had been married about six months ago to Priyanka Kumari, daughter of Bengali Mahato, resident of village-Rusulpur, police station-Punpun. After marriage, his son lived with his in-laws and started living there. After that, the mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother-in-law and sister-in-law used to fight and quarrel among themselves, whose names are as follows (1) Father-in-law Bengali Mahato (2) Mother-in-law Putul Devi (3) Daughter Priyanka Kumari (4) Mithun Kumar S/O- Bangali Mahto (5) Rohit Kumar, (6) Mithun Kumar, S/O- Sunil Sahani, all of them broke his right hand by beating him on 14/10/2025 at around 8:30 pm, and all of them together were harassing and torturing him, fed up with this, his son hanged himself.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any superior court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The alleged sections does not apply to the petitioner there is no specific allegation of theft on the petitioner. The deceased was son in law of the petitioner, the deceased used to intoxication. The deceased has committed suicide in the state of intoxication. The relation between petitioner and deceased was good. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case record and case diary. As per the case of prosecution informant's son Jitendra Kumar @ Mangal died at his

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in-laws house. Post-mortem report is on record which shows that the cause of death of the deceased is asphyxia resulting from antemortem compression of neck. Witnesses in case diary para 8 and 9 have supported the facts of the occurrence. The petitioners are named accused of the F.I.R. The case is under investigation.

Considering the above facts, circumstances, nature of occurrence and case being under investigation, this court is not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Putul Devi 2. Mithun Kumar, S/O- Bangali Mahto 3. Priyanka Kumari 3. Bangali Mahato 6. Rohit Kumar 7. Mithun Kumar, S/O- Sunil Sahani along on anticipatory bail at this stage. Therefore, the prayer of anticipatory bail of the above named accused petitioner is rejected. The anticipatory bail petition of the above named accused is dismissed.
