Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants\ 1. Manoj Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Ram Sakal Singh. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Complaint Case No:- 285(C)/2018 for offenses U/S 420, 406, 467, 471 of IPC. The case of prosecution in brief is that the complainant Uma Shankar Thakur states that on 16.04.2018 at 09:00 AM, when he was going to his office then, near 4 hospital the accused person of this case focibly seat him in a vehicle and brought to registry office masaurhi and got the document signed the vehicle itself. Again, at three PM he was taken for photography and again taken him back to the vehicle. The complainant stated that he has not received consideration money. The complainant stated that he has filed a civil suit for cancellation of the bail.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioners are ready to obey all the direction of the court. The petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offense. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Notice was issued to the complainant. Complainant or his counsel did not appear in the court. The alleged sale deed is a registered sale deed dated 16.04.2018. The complainant has filed the present complainant on 05.06.2018.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner 1. Manoj Kumar on anticipatory bail.

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Therefore, the above named accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that he surrenders in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
