Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Nityanand Kumar @ Pintu Kumar 2. Seema Sinha along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Dayanand Paswan. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case- 218/2026 for offenses U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2) 352, 351(2) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Ramvishay Kumar states that on 27.03.2026 at about 12:30 PM, he went with his son and wife to Nityanand Kumar @ Pintu Kumar to ask for the money that he had given earlier. As soon as he saw them, he started abusing them. Hearing the abuse, his wife also got furious, and he also started abusing all of them. Hearing the abuse, he said that they are keeping the money and when asked for it. They abuse them. As soon as he said this, he attacked him with an hot iron rod from his shop, due to which he and his son got injured by the hot iron rod. Seeing his wife injured, she started lifting her son, then, Nityanand started misbehaving with his wife also and threatened her saying that now he will not give him the money. They will get it, do what they want, while assaulting him, they even snatched the gold chain from his neck.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The applicants are ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Court of Additional Sessions Judge -II Masaurhi , Patna

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Heard both sides. Case Diary has been called for which is received. Perused the case record and case diary. Incident occurred due to dispute relating to money. No discription of any injury is mentioned in the prosecution case. Also, no injury report is available with the case diary. As submitted on the behalf of petitioner that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners. Nityanand Kumar @ Pintu Kumar 2. Seema Sinha on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrendar in the Lower Court within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Lower Court.
