Regular Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant Guddu Yadav who is in custody since 30.03.2026 along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Kumud Ranjan Ray . Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 28/2026 for offenses U/S 109, 118(2), 126(2), 3(5) of BNS and 27 Arms Act. The case of prosecution in brief is that Informant Santosh Kumar states that on 15.01.2026 at about 07:30 PM, informant's son Ritik Raushan and Bittu Kumar of his village had gone to see his farm on bike both were returning from farm. On the way Pappu Kumar, Nand Kumar, Shiv Kumar, Guddu Yadav, Pintu Singh, Vipin Kumar, Hariprakash Kumar and unknown were consuming drugs. All the above persons asked his son and his friend to get drunk which his son and his friend refused. Pappu Kumar told Shiv Kumar to shoot them. Shiv Kumar pulled out his pistol and fired at his son and his friend. The bullet passed through his son's upper left side and hit his friend Bittu Kumar's spine. The injured are being treated as AIIMS Patna.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the applicant has not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before Superior court. The applicant has no criminal history. The applicant is innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. Nothing is recovered from the possession of the petitioner. There is no any specific allegation of firing against the petitioner. None of the independent witnesses have supported the involvement of the petitioner in this case. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

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Heard both sides. Case Diary has been called for which is received. Perused the case record and the case diary. The allegation of firing is not against this petitioner. Investigation against the petitioner is complete. The petitioner is in custody since 30.03.2026.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner Guddu Yadav on bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond by accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
