Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 174/2026

Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant 1.Sunny Kumar
2. Suraj Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Lokesh Kumar.
Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Punpun P.S Case- 99/2026 for offenses U/ S 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that On 21.03.2026 at about 2:00 PM, the informant's son, Sachin Kumar, was working in his agricultural field and breaking clods of soil along with two other persons. At that time, accused Suraj Kumar, armed with an iron rod, allegedly came from behind and struck Sachin Kumar on the head, causing a bleeding injury. Upon hearing the commotion, the informant Rajkishore Singh and his wife Rina Devi rushed to rescue the injured. It is alleged that the other accused persons, namely Sanjeev Kumar Singh, Sunaina Devi, and Promod Kumar, formed an unlawful assembly and jointly assaulted the informant and his family members with iron rods and sticks while also hurling abuses. As a result of the assault, Sachin Kumar sustained a serious head injury, and the informant and his wife also suffered injuries. The accused persons allegedly threatened the victims with dire consequences if they reported the matter to the police. It is further alleged that during the occurrence, the accused snatched the informant's mobile phone from his pocket, causing a loss of approximately ₹15,000.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The Petitioners have no criminal antecedents. The petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. There is no possibility of fleeing or tampering with the evidence. The applicants are ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. . On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case diary is called for and is received. Perused the case diary and case record. The Informant and petitioners are relatives. The dispute took place due to plucking of vegetables. As per para 24 of case diary injury report of injured Sachin Kumar is yet not prepared.

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Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1.Sunny Kumar 2. Suraj Kumar on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrendar in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned. On receipt of injury report of injured Sachin Kumar if grievous injury is found on vital part of the body, then, the prosecution may proceed for cancellation of the bail.
