Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Chandan Kumar 2. Aditya Kumar 3. Bhuneshwar @ Jhotalla 4. Suraj Kumar 5. Puniya Bind 6. Sumanti Devi along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Sanjay Kumar. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 158/2026 for offenses U/S 126(1), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that the informant Shyamlal Bind states that 04.03.2026, they were sitting at home, his wife Ranju Devi had gone out of the house to nature's call, then three persons of the village, namely Chandan Kumar, Aditya Kumar, Bhuneshwar @ Jhotella, Suraj Kumar, Puniya Devi, all of them together started abusing his wife Ranju Devi, when he objected, they beat him up as well, due to which his brother in law cut his hand with an iron rod, and when his guest Chandan Bind went to stop the fight, he was also hit with an iron rod, due to which a finger of his hand got cut, and Ranju Devi was hit with an iron rod, due to which there is a mark of injury on her stomach.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any superior court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case record and case diary. It is submitted on the behalf of the petitioner that Informant and petitioners are own Gotia. It is also submitted that the petitioner have no criminal antecedents. As per para 36 of the case diary the injury report of injured has yet not prepared.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Chandan Kumar 2. Aditya Kumar 3. Bhuneshwar @ Jhotalla 4. Suraj

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Kumar 5. Puniya Bind 6. Sumanti Devi on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
