

Anticipatory Bail Petition No.200/2026

Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant Laxman Mochi along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Kumar Kunwar Singh. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Punpun P.S Case No:- 129/2016 for offenses U/s 126(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352 of BNS . The case of prosecution in brief is that Milan Kumar states that on 18/04/26 at 04:00 pm, he was going home from Dumari. When he reached near the house of Jageshwar Ravidas, (1) Laxman Mochi started abusing him. When He objected, he started kicking and punching him. He is handicapped. Due to this, when he fell on the ground, they snatched his stick and hit him continuously with it for 8-10 times and caught his hand on the ground and crushed it with the stick due to which the finger of his left hand got badly injured and he started shouting then many people of the village gathered and he left him and ran away then he came to the police station, by the police station they were sent to Punpun P.H.C.H for treatment then by the P.H.C.H doctor he was sent to P.M.C.H Patna for better treatment and my nephew Abhishek Kumar age-18 years father Arjun Ravidas resident of Sammanchak police station-Punpun district-Patna time was going to Dumri market at around 05:00 in the evening when Laxman Mochi started abusing him and started beating him, when he tried to escape by defending himself, he bit the finger of his right hand, he am coming to the police station after treatment from P.M.C.H.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or pampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The Case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case diary and case record. The petitioner and informant are co-villager. No injury report is yet obtained in investigation. It is submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents.

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Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner Laxman Mochi on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
