Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Ravindra Kumar 2. Pramod Kumar 3. Chachan Bind @ Chanchal Bind 4. Karan Kumar 5. Ganesh Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Raman Kant Kumar. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case- 337/2026 for offenses U/S 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that Jitendra Bind, father-Late Ramanand Bind, permanent resident of Village-Madhochak, Post-Hansadih, Police Station-Masaurhi, District-Patna, Bihar. It was his niece's wedding, whose Angiya (wedding ceremony) was being held, when on the way they were drunk and dancing with DJ music, He was going through the same route, so they started abusing him saying that He will not let you go through this route, then he was trying to make them understand when they started hitting me with sticks and started threatening me by pointing guns and bullets, then his family started shouting, hearing this his family started hitting them too in defense, the details of which are as follows, Kundan Kumar, Sangeeta Devi, Sudama Kumar were also hit with sticks and started hitting Jitendra Bind's head got cracked, Kundan Kumar's head got cracked and Sudama Kumar got injured in hands and legs and they snatched Sangeeta Devi's gold chain, the names of the person who hit and snatched it are as follows. Ravindra Kumar, father - Dashrath Bind, Karan Kumar, father - Nageshwar Bind, Ganesh Kumar, father - Nageshwar Bind, Chachan Bind, father - Nageshwar Bind, Pramod Kumar, father - Nageshwar Bind and unknown more persons.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The applicants are ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case Diary has been called for which is received. Perused the case record and case diary. Informant and petitioners are co-villagers. Dispute arose due to crossing the road. No

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injury report is yet obtained in the investigation. Witnesses in the case diary para 7 and 8 have stated that accused persons were pelting stones and bricks, however, the prosecution case is that accused persons assaulted by Lathi and Danda. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Ravindra Kumar 2. Pramod Kumar 3. Chachan Bind @ Chanchal Bind 4. Karan Kumar 5. Ganesh Kumar on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court below.
