Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Kapil Prasad 2. Shanti Devi 3. Asha Devi 4. Dimpal Kumari along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Sudharshan Kumar. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Kadirganj P.S Case No:- 235/2026 for offenses U/S 190, 126(2), 115(2), 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Shyam Sundari states that on 15/05/26, at around 07:00 am, she was at her home. At that time. Kapil Prasad, Ajit Kumar, , Asha Devi, Dimple Kumari, Suchit Kumar, Shanti Devi came to her house and started abusing her and also beat her and her daughter-in-law Mamta Devi, wife of Kaushal Kumar. During the fight, her earring and gold mangalsutra were snatched away. Hearing the noise, her son Kaushal Kumar and husband Umesh Prasad, village Tehri Bigha, police station Kadirganj, district Patna, came out and saw these people.They were also assaulted with iron rods and sticks, resulting in serious injuries.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal antecedent against them. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offense. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case record and the case diary. The informant and petitioners are co-villagers. Injury report of injured Shyam Sundar Devi, Umesh Kumar, Kaushal Kumar is on record which shows that simple nature injury was caused to them. As per para 17 of the case diary petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Kapil Prasad 2. Shanti Devi 3. Asha Dvi 4. Dimpal Kumari

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on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
