Regular Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Rohit Kumar who is in custody since 14.05.2026 along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Ravindra Sharma. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 712/2025 for offenses U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 76, 329(3), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS . The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Anita Devi stated that on 30.08.2025, at about 10:00 PM, he was sitting on my terrace. Meanwhile, Kundan Kumar, Karadish Yadav, Dayanand Kumar, Rohit Kumar. All of them together entered my house and started abusing her. When he refused to abuse. Kundan Kumar dragged me out of the house and threw her down by holding her hair, due to which he became half naked and and in that condition he hit me with an iron rod with the intention of killing him, due to which her head got cracked and a lot of blood started flowing. He fell unconscious on the ground, Jagdish Yadav snatched her mangalsutra, when her father in law came to save her. Dayanand and Rohit along with him started hitting him with sticiks and rods, due to which he got a cut above they eye and injuries all over her body and her hand got broken, and I fell unconscious on the ground and when the villagers came after hearing the noise, he ran away and threatened that he would kill him. When her close family came to know about it. They took me to the Sub-divisional hospital for treatment, from where he was referred to PMCH.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the applicant has no criminal history. The applicant is innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case diary has been called for which is received. Informant and petitioners are agnates. Injury report of injured is available on record. The injury report of injured Anita

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Devi shows that simple nature injury was caused to her. Grievous injury caused to Vidya Prasad is on the left arm. As per para 43 of the case diary the injured Vidya Prasad came to PMCH six days after the injury and did not have any document of PHC examination. The petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2026.

Considering the above facts, circumstances, nature of the allegation and period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner 1. Rohit Kumar on bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond by accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
