Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1.Jitendra Kumar 2. Amol Kumar 3. Rahis Kumar 4. Pankaj Kumar 5. Ram Pravesh Prasad along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioners Sri Rupam Kumar. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Dhanarua P.S Case No:- 214/2026 for offenses U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that on 12.04.2026 at about 12:00 noon, while the informant was levelling his land with a JCB, the accused persons allegedly arrived there, abused and assaulted him with lathi and iron rod. It is alleged that Jitendra Kumar demanded ₹5,00,000/- and threatened to stop the work, while the accused persons forcibly took cash of ₹11,000/-, a gold chain weighing about 15 grams and a gold ring weighing about 5 grams from the informant. The informant further alleged that due to the assault he became unconscious and that the accused persons also threatened him with dire consequences. Accordingly, he requested for legal action after investigation.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any superior court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offense. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case record and the case diary. There is land dispute between the parties. Injury repport of injured Amit Sahgal is on record which shows that simple nature injury was caused to him. It is submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1.Jitendra Kumar 2. Amol Kumar 3. Rahis Kumar 4. Pankaj

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Kumar 5. Ram Pravesh Prasad on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
