Regular Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicant Kamlesh Kumar @ Sokhan who is in custody since 02.06.2026 along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Shri Sanjay Kumar. Copy of the petition is served on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Masaurhi P.S Case No:- 311/2026 for offenses U/S 115(2), 126(2), 352, 109(1), 3(5) of BNS . The case of prosecution in brief is that informant stated on 25-11-2026 at about 7:30 AM, the informant Rinku Devi and her husband Pappu Kumar had gone towards the east of their house to graze cattle and pluck vegetables. At that time, Kamlesh Kumar @ Lokesh and his wife Menika Devi allegedly abused them, assaulted them, and during the altercation launched a murderous attack. It is alleged that Rinku Devi sustained a head injury, became unconscious and fell to the ground, while Pappu Kumar also suffered injuries.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the petitioner has not filed any bail petition before sessions court or any higher court. The applicant has no criminal history. The applicant is innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Case diary has been called for which is received. Petitioner and Informant are own brothers. Witness in case diary para 10 has stated about the land dispute between them. Final injury report of the injured Rinku Devi is contained it para 66 of the case diary which shows that simple nature injury was caused to her. The petitioner is in custody since 02.06.2026.

Considering the above facts, circumstances, nature of the allegation and period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner 1. Kamlesh Kumar @ Sokhan on bail.

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Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond by accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
