Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Mahendra Singh 2. Kapildeo Singh 3. Ajit Singh 4. Sudhir Kumar 5. Santosh Kumar 6. Nagina Yadav 7. Arun Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioners Shri Kumar Gaurav. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Complaint Case No.- 64 (C)/2022 for offenses U/s 467, 468, 420, 120 B of IPC. The case of prosecution in brief is that one Ram Bahal Singh and Rajendra Singh were two brothers the plot no. 34 under khata no. 35 area 41 decimal and plot no. 98 under khata 28 area 11 decimal belong to these two brothers on 25.03.1963 both brothers sold the land to Ram Swarup Singh. On 22.06.1972 Ram Swarup Singh sold the land to Ram Chandra Singh. Ram Chandra Singh was grandfather of the complainant and was paying the land revenue. The accused no. 2 and 3 illegally obtained revenue receipt of the plot no. 34 , area 41 decimal and sold it to accused Arun Kumar. On 27.06.2000. On 11.02.2022 when the complainant opposed the accused persons. The complainant was assaulted and his gold chain was snatched.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any court. The applicants have no criminal history in which he is on bail. The accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case with false allegations. There is no possibility of fleeing or tampering with the evidence. The applicants are ready to file bail-bond to the satisfaction of the court. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. Notice was issued to the complainant. Ld. Counsel for the complainant appeared. It is submitted by the petitioners that petitioner no. 1 and

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petitioner no. 4 belong to the family of Khatiyani Raiyat of alleged land. Land Revenue is also being paid on their behalf. Copy of revenue receipt is also filed in support of their claim. It is submitted that title suit 1992 of 2023 is also pending in respect of the alleged land.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Mahendra Singh 2. Kapildeo Singh 3. Ajit Singh 4. Sudhir Kumar 5. Santosh Kumar 6. Nagina Yadav 7. Arun Kumar on anticipatory bail Therefore, the above named accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrendar in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
