Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on the behalf of Accused Applicants 1. Sukhdeo Prasad @ Surajdeo Prasad 2. Sarvesh Prasad @ Sidheshwar 3. Ranjay Kumar along with fresh power by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner Sri Satyendra Paswan. Copy of the petition is serve on Ld. APP for the state.

The above name accused petitioners are named in Dhanarua P.S Case No:- 329/2026 for offenses U/s 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS. The case of prosecution in brief is that On 24.05.2026 at about 8:00 PM, the informant Satyendra Kumar parked his CNG tempo near the bridge under the jurisdiction of Dhanarua Police Station, Patna. A dispute arose when Anil Kumar objected to parking the vehicle there. Later, while the informant was returning home, the accused persons, namely Anil Kumar, Sukhdev Prasad, Sarvesh Prasad, Pooja Kumari, Soni Kumari, Soni Kumari and Rajay Kumar, allegedly intercepted him on the road, abused him, and assaulted him with lathis and an iron rod, causing injuries to his hands and legs. On hearing the alarm, the informant's brother Sikendra Kumar reached the spot to intervene. It is alleged that Anil Kumar struck Sikendra Kumar on the head with an iron rod with the intention to kill, causing a serious head injury. During the occurrence, the accused allegedly snatched ₹1,600 from the informant's pocket and a gold chain locket from the neck of Sikendra Kumar. The injured were first taken to the Community Health Centre, Dhanarua, and thereafter referred to PMCH, Patna for better treatment.

Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the applicants have not previously filed any anticipatory or regular bail application before any superior court. The applicants have no criminal history. The applicants are innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the prosecution case. There is no chance of absconding of the petitioner or tampering with evidence. The petitioner is ready to obey all the direction of the court. The petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offense. On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer the bail.

Heard both sides. The case diary has been called for and is received. Perused the case record and the case diary. Allegation of assault on the head of the brother of informant Sikandar

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Kumar is against the accused Anil Kumar who is not petitioner in this case. Injuries except head injury are simple in nature. Para 29 of the case diary shows that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

Considering the above facts, circumstances and nature of the case this court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners 1. Sukhdeo Prasad @ Surajdeo Prasad 2. Sarvesh Prasad @ Sidheshwar 3. Ranjay Kumar on anticipatory bail. Therefore, the above named accused petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to provision under Section 482(2) BNSS on condition that they surrender in the Court Concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of the order or on being arrested, on furnishing a bail bond by each accused with two surities of rupees 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Court Concerned.
