07.03.2026	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. This anticipatory bail application filed on 06.02.2026, on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Juber Ali @ Md. Juber Ali, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case no. 1501/2012 registered for the offence u/s. 494, 498(A) of I.P.C. &amp; Section 4 of the D.P. Act is put up for hearing.</li><li>2. Heard Smt. Bandana Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Sri A.K.Tiwary, learned P.P. appearing for the State.</li><li>3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that the marriage of the complainant, Farida Khatoon was solemnized three and a half years ago of the alleged incident. After marriage, she went to her matrimonial house where her husband and other in-laws tortured her for not paying Rs. 50,000/- cash and a Hero Honda motorcycle in dowry. It is further alleged that the accused persons sent the complainant to her father's house along with her father and her husband, in pursuit of dowry, married a woman named Satkotra Khatoon for the second time.</li><li>4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated</li></ol>

in this case. It has been further submitted that the complainant herself refused to live with the petitioner. She got a Khulanama Talaque executed in her name in the presence of both parties of her own free will. The petitioner did not understand properly that the case is still pending in the court and as soon as he received notice, he came to know about it. The petitioner has clean antecedent. There is no chance of his absconding. So, prayed for anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. I have heard the rival submission of both parties and perused the original case record. Allegation against the petitioner is that prior to three and a half years of the alleged incident, he married the complainant and then left her due to non-fulfillment of dowry demanded by him and remarried another woman. The complainant was sent a notice by this court on 12.02.2026 to present her side in the court but she did not appear for two consecutive dates, despite she was given ample opportunity to appear before the court. From the perusal of certified copy of Khulanama Talaq it appears that the complainant and the petitioner were divorced on 24.01.2022 through Khulanama Talaque by the families of both parties, due to which the relationship between them as husband and wife ended. After the proceeding of Khula, the case might be disposed.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, Juber Ali @ Md. Juber Ali is **allowed** and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender he will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below within a fortnight
