Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 283/2026

The bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Shekhar Kumar Bosak and it has been sought for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Baisi P.S. Case No. 495/2025 disclosing offences punishable u/s 64(1), 351(2)/3(5) of BNS, 2023.

2. The LCR along with the case diary is available with the bail case record. The petitioner in para 2 of the bail application has given a certificate with respect to non-filing of any earlier bail application before this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The victim XXX is present before the Court by filing her hazari.
3. Heard the learned counsel Sri Raman Kr. Jha appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the **victim** through Sri Rahul Raja, the learned APP appearing on behalf of the opposite party.
4. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence of rape upon the victim as alleged against him and the victim herself remained roaming around the petitioner since one year and the petitioner has got clean past and the FIR has been lodged against the petitioner for making pressure and he apprehends his arrest at the hands of the police. On these grounds, it has been prayed for grant of the anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer of bail submitting that there is direct allegation of rape upon the victim by the petitioner and the investigation is going on.

5. The prosecution case, in short, is that the victim XXX has got an FIR lodged on 11.12.2025 alleging therein that she used to go computer class at Charaiya and the petitioner started roaming with her by making false promise of marriage and he also began to make physical relationship with her in hotel and thereafter, she became pregnant and the petitioner told her to abort her pregnancy and also denied to solemnise marriage with her and when her family members went to the petitioner's house, his family members threatened and also denied to solemnise marriage and hence the FIR.
6. Perused the bail application along with the complete LCR including the case diary (para 1-44) which appears that para 6 of the case diary describes the place of the occurrence and the para 8-10 of the case diary reveals the statement of the witnesses establishing the

factum of the alleged incident of rape on false promise of marriage and the victim present before the Court also alleges about rape upon her by the petitioner and the statement of the victim recorded u/s. 183 of BNSS, 2023 also asserts about the sexual relationship forcefully upon the victim by the petitioner and the victim has stated therein that the petitioner lured her to Dalkola lodge on 28.03.2025 and he raped her. On perusal, it also appears that both the parties are familiar prior to the incident but the materials collected in the case diary indicate about the petitioner's sole intention to seduce the victim to indulge in sexual acts under cheating and there is direct allegation of rape against the petitioner and the investigation is going on.

7. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail made on behalf of the accused petitioner Shekhar Kumar Bosak stands *rejected*.
