O R D E R

1. An anticipatory bail petition, dated 21-02-2026, supported with an affidavit, has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioners in connection with Champanagar P. S. Case No. 25/2026, U/s- 316(2),318(4),352,351(2),3(5) of B.N.S and was pressed today for hearing by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners. A copy of petition was also served upon to ld. Adl. P.P. Heard Sri P.S. Parag, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, as well as Sri Rahul Raja, Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

2. Brief of the case, as per the F.I.R is that, on 03.11.2025, informant's younger son Md. Kalam, purchased one motorcycle bearing registration number BR11BT5187 from petitioner no.1 for rupees 1,30,000/- under agreement. On 10.12.2025, when informant's son went to T.V.S show room service center for servicing of bike then service center manager seized the said motorcycle and demanded rupees 50,000/-. Informant went to the house of petitioner no.1 and stated the incident then petitioner no. 1 gave a motorcycle bearing reg. no BR11BS4541, without any agreement for some day. After some day petitioners started threatening informant's son and started demanding his motorcycle and further threatened to kill if not returned his motorcycle.

Police was informed and F.I.R was lodged accordingly.

3. Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and committed no offence as alleged. There is delayed F.I.R without any cogent reason. Informant's son purchased the motorcycle under agreement and rupees 50,000/- was left as dues with petitioner no.1 and the said motorcycle was recovered and seized by the TVS showroom manager due to which the informant's son along with associates started demanding rangadari and tried to kidnap petitioner no. 1 from his house but could not succeed and they took away the Motorcycle bearing reg no. BR11BS4541 of petitioner Md. Mansur Alam. There is a case and counter case vide Champanagar P.S case no. 21/2026. The petitioner are local persons have got their home and hearth and as such there is no chance of their absconding and are ready to furnish solvent bailors. Hence, let the petitioners be granted bail.

4. The Ld A.P.P opposed the prayer of bail.

5. Heard the rival submission and Perused. There is case and counter case. The instant case appears as of civil nature dispute. Informant is present thought his Ld. Advocate and they do not objected on the submission of the petitioners and grant of bail. Benefit of section 35(3) BNSS has been granted to the petitioners. The petitioners have given undertaking that they will cooperate in trial and will not temper the evidence. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioners is hereby **allowed**. The above named petitioners are directed to be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of fifteen days from receipt of this order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below.
