Criminal Misc. Petition filed on behalf of the petitioner to extend the period for surrendering before the learned Court below in connection with Baisi P.S. Case No. 23 of 2026 in the light of order dated 27.01.2026 passed by this Court in A.B.P. No. 161 of 2026.

ORDER

1. This instant Cr. Miscellaneous Petition filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Aasiya Khatoon for extension of period of her surrender before the learned Court below in the light of order dated 27.01.2026 passed by this Court in A.B.P. No. 161/2026 (C.I.S. No. 161/2026) arising out of Baisi P.S. Case No. 23 of 2026 registered for the offence under section 135 of Indian Electricity Act, 2003.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that above named petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 27.01.2026 in A.B.P. No. 161/2026 (C.I.S. No. 161/2026) arising out of Baisi P.S. Case No. 23 of 2026 with a direction that she in the event of surrender within a fortnight from the date of receipt of the order before the Court below or arrest, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 482 BNSS with further condition that before furnishing the bail bond, the petitioner will deposit 50% of the total amount (Rs. 26,032.50/-) in the

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concerned electricity department and submit a copy of the deposit slip at the time of furnishing the bail bond. But, the petitioner of instant Cr. Miscellaneous on the ground that as per order, the petitioner failed to deposit 50% of the outstanding amount with the concerned electricity department within the stipulated time due to lack of money. As such she could not furnish bail bond within time. Now the petitioner wants to deposit 50% of the outstanding amount in the concerned department for which she seeks permission. So, it is prayed to extend the period for surrendering the petitioner before the learned Court below in the above referred case.

3. The contentions put forward on behalf of the petitioner appears to be convincing.

4. Considering the aforesaid facts and submission of the party, the period of above named petitioner arrest or surrender is extended for a further period of 10 (ten) days from the date of receipt of this order with the conditions as laid down in the order dated 27.01.2026 passed in A.B.P. No. 161/2026 (C.I.S. No. 161/2026), arising out of Baisi P.S. Case No. 23/2026. Accordingly, this Cr. Miscellaneous is allowed. The petitioner is further directed to deposit Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred) in the Advocates' Welfare Fund, District Bar Association, Purnea as cost and its deposit slip will be produced before the learned court below at the time of furnishing bail bond.
