15.06.2026	1. This anticipatory bail application filed on 14.05.2026, on behalf of the petitioner namely, Md. Mubarak @ Mubarak Alam, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with C.A. Case no. 2036/2025 registered for the offence u/s. 85 of BNS & 3/4 D.P.Act is put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Sanjay Kumar Dabur, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Sri Uday Keshri, learned P.P. I/c appearing for the State assisted by Sri Firoz Akhtar, learned counsel for the complainant. 3. The complaint petition filed by complainant Gajiya Parween, in brief is that on 04.07.2017, her marriage was solemnized with the petitioner. In her matrimonial house she was subjected to cruelty by her husband and his family members when her parents were unable to fulfill the demand for a dowry of Rs. 2,00,000/- made by them. The complainant has also alleged that her husband has entered into a second marriage with a woman, namely, Bibi Lucy. 4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready to keep his wife (complainant) with him with full dignity and respect and also ready to comply with the directions of the court. The petitioner has a clean antecedent. So, prayed for anticipatory bail.	

Contd. 15.06.2026	On the other hand, learned P.P. I/c has opposed the prayer for bail. 5. I have heard the rival submission of both the parties and perused the original case record. From perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioner is the husband of the complainant. There was a dispute between them regarding their marital life but now both of them are ready to reside together. The complainant appears in the Court and supports this and says that the dispute between her and her husband and other in-laws is over and now she wants to live her life with her husband. The petitioner also appears in the court and says that he will keep his wife with him with dignity and honour. In this regard, an undertaking has been filed by the petitioner which is attached to this record. It seems that good sense has been prevailed between the parties. 6. Under the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, namely, Md. Mubarak @ Mubarak Alam is allowed. He, in the event of surrender within a fortnight from the date of receipt of this order before the Court below or arrest, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to conditions as laid down u/s. 482 BNSS. If such atrocities by the petitioner on his wife (complainant) come to light again then learned court below is in liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
