10.06.2026	1. This bail petition filed on 16.05.2026, on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Nabista, who is in judicial custody since 23.04.2026, in connection with Angarh P.S. Case no.- 66/2026 registered for the offence u/s. 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S. is put up for hearing. 2. Heard Md. Andlib Monu, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Uday Keshri, learned P.P. I/c appearing for the State. 3. On the written complaint of informant Suhana, F.I.R. lodged against five accused persons including petitioner herein, it is case of prosecution that on 23.04.2026, between 1:00 p.m. and 02:30 p.m., Nabisata, Naimoddin (father of Nabista), Naazmin, (mother of Nabisata), Khusnoor (sister of Nabisata), Khushnati (sister of Nabisata) and Nafees (brother of Nabisata) together violently murdered informant's father Md. Ashfaq Ansari by pressing his genitals. Due to this attack, her father suffered internal injuries and was murdered. This incident occurred at informant's home in Village- Dhusmal, P.S. Angarh, District- Purnea. Eyewitnesses to this incident are Jalerun Nisha and Anwari Begam. 4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has got one criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that the deceased Ashfaq Ansari and the husband of the petitioner are own brothers. Actually, the deceased was suffering from several diseases including heart disease and he	

Contd. 10.06.2026	died because of illness. It has been further submitted that the petitioner has three infants and she is pregnant again. The petitioner is a local woman and there is no chance of her absconding away. So, prayed for anticipatory bail. On the other hand, learned P.P. I/c strongly opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner. 5. I have heard the rival submissions of both parties and perused the case record and case dairy. The petitioner is a named accused in the F.I.R. and there is a specific allegation against her of killing informant's father by squeezing his testicles. The petitioner has stated in her confessional statement that the deceased died after suddenly falling during the altercation. But, in postmortem report of deceased Asfak Ansari, it is clearly mentioned in the 'External Examination' column that one bruise size 1.5"x1" was present over left side scrotal region. One bruise 1"x0.5" was present over left side occipital region. Final opinion of cause of death is kept pending till report of viscera examination report is received. Prima facie the case appears to be of killing the father of the informant by pressing his private part. Investigation of the case is still pending. 6. Under the facts and circumstances as discussed above, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of petitioner, Nabista is, hereby, rejected.
