This is an common application under Sec. 482 BNSS filed on behalf of applicant/accused persons namely Nand Kishore Rai @ Nandu & Santosh @ Jatta for grant of anticipatory bail.

Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant submits that no bail application is pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Common reply to the bail application qua both the accused/applicants has been filed on behalf of IO. Same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to Ld. Counsel for accused/applicants.

Ld. Counsel for both the accused/applicants submits that the accused/applicants have nothing to do with the commission of offence. He submits that main allegations are against co-accused Suraj who was having affair with the deceased. He further submits that accused/applicant Nandu reached at the spot of incident after the death of deceased only. He further submits that allegations against both the accused/applicants are that after the death of deceased, they abused the family members of deceased. He submits that the

present application may be allowed and the accused/applicants may be granted anticipatory bail.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State assisted by IO submits that the role of accused/applicants is yet to be ascertained and the decision with respect to requirement of arrest of both the accused/applicants will be taken by the IO after collection of evidence.

Since there is no requirement of arrest of both the accused/applicants at this stage but their arrest may be required at later stage, I deem it appropriate to grant interim protection to both the accused/applicants.

No cocercive action be taken both the accused/applicants till next date of hearing. Both the accused/applicants are directed to join the investigation as and when required by the IO through a written notice.

Put up for filing of further investigation progress report and arguments on bail application on 13.04.2026.

A copy of this order be given dasti to all concerned.
