02.06.2026	1. This bail petition filed on 06.05.2026, on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Babul, who is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026, in connection with Dagarua P.S. Case no.-31/2026 registered for the offence u/s. 303(2) of B.N.S. & added section 317(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Wasim Iqbal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Uday Keshri, learned P.P. I/c appearing for the State. 3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 22.01.2026, at around 7:00 P.M., informant had parked his Super Splendor motorcycle (Registration No. BR11AF-8548; Engine No. JA05EG59B38586; Chassis No. MBLJAR039J9B38233) which he had received as a gift during his wedding from its original owner, Md. Tajuddin (son of Ghulam Rasul, resident of Village Gandwas, P.S. Dagarua, District Purnea) on the road situated near Hichhamoti Pulwa, within the jurisdiction of the Dagarua Police Station. The informant had gone a short distance away to attend nature call and during this brief interval, the aforementioned vehicle was stolen by unknown thieves. 4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and no incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. Only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused persons, he has	

Contd./- 02.06.2026	been made an accused in this case. It has also been submitted by him that there is no criminal history against the petitioner and the petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. So, prayed for bail. On the other hand, learned P.P. I/c strongly opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner. 5. I have heard the rival submission of both parties and perused the case record and case diary. From perusal of the same it appears that this case pertains to the theft of the informant's Super Splendor motorcycle (Registration No. BR11AF8548) by unidentified thieves. Although the petitioner is not named accused in the F.I.R., but during the investigation police was informed through intelligence sources that the petitioner and co-accused persons, all residents of Mahmadiya, Rahika Tola, Ward No. 01, P.S. Dagarua, District Purnea, are currently operating the stolen motorcycle from their homes and are attempting to sell the said vehicle. Then, on the basis of confessional statements of co-accused persons, the said stolen motorcycle was recovered by the police from petitioner's house (para 27 of the case diary). From the perusal of original case record it also appears that charge has already been framed against the petitioner and three others under sections 303(2), 317(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. 6. Under the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the prayer for bail of the petitioner, namely, Babul is allowed on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to conditions that (1) one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner and (2) the petitioner will remain physically present, as directed by the	
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Contd./- 02.06.2026	Court, on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned court below and also to cooperate in the trial of the case.
