15.06.2026	1. This bail application filed on 03.06.2026, on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Md. Safique, who is in judicial custody since 07.05.2026 in connection with Kasba P.S. Case no. 152/2026 registered for the offence u/s. 126(2), 115(2), 69, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS is put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Ashish Kumar Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Sri Uday Keshri, learned P.P. I/c appearing for the State assisted by Md. Faiyaz, learned counsel for the informant. 3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that informant Sajan Khatoon is the wife of Md. Taiyab, but she did not have any children with him. Meanwhile, Md. Safique, who is already married lured her in his love trap and had physical relations with her by giving her false promises of children and marriage. Then both were caught by the villagers and handed over to the police. Then Md. Safique and co-accused persons tried to kill the informant in various ways. Somehow she save herself and came to Jeevan Toli. 4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It has been further submitted that the petitioner is ready to keep the informant with him as his wife. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.05.2026. So, prayed for bail. On the other hand, learned P.P. I/c assisted by learned counsel for the informant has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner. 5. I have heard the rival submission of both the parties and perused

From perusal of the same, it appears that the informant is a married woman but for want of a child, she, with her consent came in a relationship with the petitioner. On receiving notice, the informant appeared in the court with her counsel. The petitioner was also produced in court from custody. Both of them stated before the court that the relationship between them is consensual. The informant says that her husband divorced her, so she wants to live with the petitioner as his wife. The petitioner is ready to marry the informant and accord her the status of his wife. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.05.2026. 6. Under the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the prayer for bail of the petitioner Md. Safique is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking at the time of furnishing his bail bond indicating that within a month of his release from jail, he will marry the informant and keep her with him as his wife. Also, he will properly cover the expenses for the informant and the child yet to be born. If the informant again files any complaint against the petitioner before the learned court below while they are living together, the learned court below is in liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
