The present execution petition pertains to the judgment/decree dated 18.02.2026.

Perusal of the record shows that JD had sought time on the LDOH to pay the decretal amount. JD appearing through VC today again seeks time to pay the decretal amount.

It is submitted on behalf of the DH that despite the judgment/decree, the JD has failed to satisfy the decretal amount. It is further submitted that during the pendency of the main suit as well as in the other execution proceedings, the JD has repeatedly sought time to make payment. On the last date of hearing, the JD expressed his readiness and willingness to pay the decretal amount and, at his request, time was granted till today. However, despite having sought such indulgence from the Court, the JD has failed to make any payment.

Perusal of the record (main suit and execution petition no. 1659/25) shows that since the inception of the proceedings, the conduct of the JD before this Court has been marked by repeated requests for adjournments and assurances of payment, followed by non-compliance. In order to balance the equities between the parties, this Court has granted sufficient opportunities to the JD from time to time. Even the learned counsel for the DH has accommodated such requests on several occasions. Despite these indulgences, the JD has failed to honour

his commitments.

This Court is constrained to observe that the conduct of the JD reflects a complete disregard for the process of law and the orders of the Court. Accordingly, the JD is burdened with costs of Rs. 15,000/- to be deposited with the Delhi Bar Association. The receipt thereof shall be placed on record on the next date of hearing.

Further, despite repeatedly expressing his readiness and willingness to satisfy the decree, the JD has failed to do so. In the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is satisfied that coercive steps are now warranted.

The surplus amount of Rs. 10,813/- received by DH in the execution petition no. 1659/25 shall be adjusted from the decretal amount awarded in the present execution petition.

Accordingly, issue warrants of arrest against the JD through the concerned DCP, subject to the filing of the process fee and subsistence allowance, and subject to filing of the affidavit by DH regarding there being no stay in the matter. Steps to be taken within 10 days from today.

Matter be listed before ACJ for appointment of Bailiff on 11.06.2026 and before this court on 11.07.2026.
