ORDER

10.03.2026

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed by above named petitioners in connection with Sasaram (Town) P.S. Case No.-57 of 2026, U/Ss.- 126(2), 115 (2), 109(1), 324(2), 352, 351(2)/3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

As per F.I.R., the informant has alleged that on 24.01.2026, when he along with his staff Shani Kumar went to take back his sound box near *Takiya Samiti* gate and asked for money, the people in drunken position of the committee including petitioners started assaulting him and his staff by means of stone, belt and *kada* due to which his staff got head injury.

Learned counsel on behalf of petitioners submitted that earlier no bail application either regular or anticipatory has ever been filed either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence. They have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submitted that both the parties are neighbour of the same locality. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. There is case and counter case between the parties. Learned counsel prayed to allow anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners.

On the other hand, learned P.P. has opposed this bail application. He submitted that the petitioners have assaulted the informant and his staff due to which they sustained injury. He prayed to reject anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners.

Heard both sides and perused the record and case diary.

There is case and counter case between the parties. There is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. Moreover, as per injury report mentioned in para 39 of the case diary, nature of injury is simple. Further, as per para 34 of the case diary, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In view of facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on merit of the case, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners is hereby **allowed**, let the petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court within a period of 15 days from the date of this order, on furnishing bail- bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties each like amount to the satisfaction of the court subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482 (2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
