ORDER

16.03.2026 Heard the ld. Counsel for the petitioners who has submitted before this court that it is a matter arose out of conjugal relations deteriorated between the informant and her husband and the applicants are in-laws who has nothing to do with the allegations which are the basis of arrying these petitioners in the F.I.R. He has prayed to pass the order of no-coercive of in-laws of the applicant.

Per contra, the ld. P.P. has not opposed the prayer.

Counsel for the accused persons, it appears that the order of no coercive is passed in favour of the petitioners/accused persons till the disposal of this file. As the ld.
