ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed by above named petitioner in connection with Kochas P.S. Case No.- 249 of 2025, U/S.- 303 (2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

As per F.I.R., the informant has alleged that on 08.10.2025 at about 12:00 A.M., he parked his motorcycle registration no. BR24-E-7200 at his door and went to Banaras. Thereafter, when he returned, he found that his motorcycle was not there.

Learned counsel on behalf of petitioner submitted that earlier no bail application either regular or anticipatory has ever been filed either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. Neither motorcycle nor incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. The occurrence is said to be happened on 08.10.2025 but FIR was lodged on 11.10.2025. There is no criminal antecedent of the petitioner. Learned counsel prayed to allow anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned P.P has opposed this anticipatory bail application.

Heard both sides and perused the record and case diary.

As per para 39 of the case diary, the petitioner and co-accused namely Sagar Mali are named in Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 1031/25 and the motorcycle involved in this case has been recovered from Sagar Mali. In the present case, F.I.R. has been lodged against unknown persons and name of the petitioner has come in the case only on the basis of Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 1031/25. Moreover, the petitioner has submitted that he has no criminal antecedent.

In view of facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on merit of the case, anticipatory bail petition of petitioner is hereby **allowed**, let the petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court within a period of 15 days from the date of this order, on furnishing bail- bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties each like amount to the satisfaction of the court subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482 (2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
