ORDER

16.03.2026 Heard the ld. Counsel for the petitioners and the Ld. Counsel privately engaged on behalf of the informant and the ld. P.P. as well.

Heard the ld. Counsel for the parties that the matter has been arose between the conjugal relations deteriorated in past between the husband and wife. As the husband of the victim is residing at Ahmedabad working as engineer, this appears to be a case where the liberties to the parties may be extended so that the parties may settle the dispute amicably.

Per contra, the ld. P.P. has not opposed the prayer.

In view of the urges so made on behalf of the ld. Counsel for the accused persons, it appears that the order of no coercive is passed in favour of the petitioners/accused persons till the disposal of this file. As the ld. Counsel for the applicants is required to look into the matter to see as to how the issue of the things may be amicably settle between the parties. Meanwhile, the ld. P.P. is directed to submit up to date case diary.
