**02.04.2026** This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of accused / petitioner named above who apprehends his arrest in connection with Kochas P. S. Case No. 307/2025), U/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 3(5) BNS.

The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the prosecution story in brief is that on 30.12.2025 informant Ajay Kumar Yadav gave written report before Thana Adhyaksh, Kochas to the effect that on the aforesaid date the informant was going to his dalan in the meantime all of a sudden the informant said to open A/C then accused replied that he don't know about the A/c. Is further alleged that on this reason petitioners abused the informant and assaulted with lathi and rod she sustained injury on head. It is further alleged that Mukesh Kumar assaulted with rod on the head of the informant and and she fell down on the ground. On commotion people arrived there and brought injured to Hospital at PHC, Kochas.

Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent previously. The entire allegation in the prosecution case is false, baseless and concocted with a view to harass and humiliate the petitioner implicated in this case. On the alleged date of occurrence petitioner's father filed a complaint case being No. 23 of 2026 against the informant and other while which is pending in the court of shri Narun Kumar, J.M., Sasaram. The petitioner is ready to obey the conditions as laid down U/s 482(2) of the BNSS. The petitioner is ready to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned court below. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner prays to release the petitioner on bail.

**Cont.....**The learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Heard the parties and perused the record. On perusal of the record I find that this case has been registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 3(5) BNS. It further reveals that there is no allegation of assault against the petitioner as per the alleged offence. There is one counter blast of complaint case 23/2026 against the informant and others of this case which is pending in the court of Judicial Magistrate -I, Sasaram. There is no criminal antecedents of the petitioner. There is no substantial material against the petitioner to refuse the anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case discussed, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly petitioner's prayer for grant of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below on his arrest or surrender within 15 days from the date of this order.
