21.04.2026 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of accused / petitioners named above who apprehend their arrest in connection with Parsathua P. S. Case No. 11/2026, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 3(5) BNS.

The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the prosecution story in brief is that the informant filed a petition that he had cultivated wheat crops in plot No.67 of Khata No.62/81 at 7 AM on 19.02.2026, the petitioners started uprooting the peg installed by getting the land measured by the C O. When son of the informant went there and told the petitioners, they assaulted indiscriminately his sons and brother Mahendra Singh by knife and injured them. The police was informed on telephone No.112 when the police came and intervened and told him and accused to come to police station.

Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case by the informant for saving his neck and necks of his family members from the clutches of Parsathua P. S. Case No. 10/2026 where in petitioner is the informant. All sections of BNS save 118(1) and 109(1) areailable. Sections 118(1) and

Cont..... 109(1) BNS are not attracted at all. Had the intention of the petitioner been to kill the injured persons they would have killed them in the absence of any intervention on the part of the members of the informant side. From the perusal of FIR it is admittedly clear that the informant did not see the occurrence. It is also clear from the FIR, that the dispute took place due to land dispute. Petitioner No.1 is a retired head Master of Middle school and is 75 years old. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedents against the petitioner. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners prays to release the petitioners on bail.

The learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record, I find that this case is registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 3(5) BNS. It further reveals that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners for the alleged offence. The occurrence took place when the petitioners started uprooting the peg (Khuti) installed in the field when objected then the petitioners assaulted the sons of the informant and his brother being land dispute between the parties. The doctor found all the injuries to be simple in nature caused by hard object. There is counter blast of Parsathua P. S Case No.10/2026 lodged by the defence party against the prosecution party. There in no criminal antecedents of the petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case discussed, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly petitioners prayer for grant of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below on their arrest or surrender within 15 days from the date of this order.
