**ORDER**

**02.04.2026** This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of accused / petitioners named above who apprehend their arrest in connection with Kochas P. S. Case No. 21/2026, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351, 352, 303(2), 3(5) BNS.

The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that a written report was given by informant Mukesh Kumar to SHO Kochas on 26.01.2026 making an allegation that he is chairperson of Bazar samittee, Kochas. On 26.01.2026 he was present in Bazar Samittee for flagging national flag in the meantime one Basant Kumar made hurdle and tried to dire consequences. The informant hoisted national Flag at 11 AM after that an application was given by Niranjana Kesari before him in which he had mentioned that Basant Kumar Singh has locked godown of Bazar Samittee after this the informant went there then accused Basant Kumar Singh alongwith other named accused persons came there then Basant Kumar Singh assaulted the informant by means of Rami agccused Sri Bhagwan Singh assaulted the informant by danda and snatched one gold chain of 2 bhar. Accused Sona and Monu opened fire upon the informant. It is mentioned in FIR that the accused persons have committed this occurrence after making criminal conspiracy.

Ld. Counsel further submits that the all the sections of this case areailable except 109(1), 303(2) BNS & 27 Arms Act which are supper addition added only with a view to make the case non-ailable. The petitioners have no criminal history. The allegation which has been made in the FIR is totally false and other co-accused persons have been allowed bail by the Ld. ADJ-III such type of occurrence has not take place the whole FIR is against truth. The

**Cont.....** petitioners are men of means so no question arises of their absconding or tampering with the evidence. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner prays to release the petitioner on bail.

The learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Heard the parties and perused the record. On perusal of the record I find that this case has been registered 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351, 352, 303(2), 3(5) BNS. It further reveals that the occurrence took place due to flag hoisting on 26.01.2026 by the informant and further the one of the co-accused locked the godown of the informant, it is also found that there is specific allegation against the petitioner No.2 for making gunshot fire and three empty cartridges were also found at the place of occurrence, so for the injury sustained and found one lacerated wound over the right perital temporal region about 1.5 inch in length, 0.5 mm width and skin depth and pain and swelling over right dorsum of hand and pain over chest caused by hard and blunt substance which was later on C.T. Scan of injured Mukesh Kumar found to be no significant abnormality is seen in brain parenchyma, there is no specific allegation against the petitioner No.1. Investigation is going on.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case discussed, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner No.1 on anticipatory bail. Accordingly petitioner prayer for grant of anticipatory bail of Petitioner No.1 is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below on his arrest or surrender within 15 days from the date of this order. So far the bail of Petitioner No.2 is concerned it stands rejected accordingly.
