He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 103, 61(2) BNS 2023 and 27 Arms Act. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioner no. 01 to 05, 06 to 12 and 13, 14 have been rejected by the court of S.D.J.M., Bikramganj vide order dated 03.02.2026, 31.01.2026 and 05.02.2026 respectively. Hence the instant bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Sima Kumari. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and six others for the offence punishable under sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 103, 61(2) BNS 2023 and 27 Arms Act for murder of informant's husband namely Arbind Kumar Singh.</p> <p>On perusal it transpire that informant in her further statement at para 04 of CD and other witnesses at para 06, 07, 08, 09, 41 and 42 of CD have supported the prosecution version of the case. The injuries is over the vital part of the body causing death of the informant's husband namely Arbind Kumar Singh. The perusal of case dairy prima facie revels that injuries are caused by Firearms which has been recovered from the house of accused Manoj Singh (A-6). Para 50 of case dairy prima facie revels that the petitioners have criminal antecedent and petitioner 3 & 4 are of clean antecedent. The firearms injury has been found in postmortem report shows the intentions, which major elements of sec 103 of B.N.S. The petitioners are in judicial custody but the case is still under investigation.</p>
