Case no. 328/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the BNS.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Bijay Prasad, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to ulterior motive and blackmailing the petitioner. He further submits that this case is counter blast of Dawath P.S. Case no. 330/2025 registered by co-accused. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the BNS. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Rahul Kumar Singh.
