01.04.2026	<p>Bail application along with power has been filed on behalf of Petitioner Anand Kumar who is in judicial custody since <b>08.02.2026</b> in connection with <b>Natwar P.S Case No. 168/2025</b>, registered u/s 318(4), 316(2) and 303(2) of BNS, 2023 and 7 Essential Commodities Act.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Narendra Kumar Singh, Learned counsel for petitioner have submitted that petitioner is innocent have committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to some annoyance and ulterior motive. He is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 318(4), 316(2) and 303(2) of BNS, 2023 and 7 7 Essential Commodities Act. and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioners have been rejected by the court of S.D.J.M, Bikramganj on 11.02.2026. Hence the instant bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Pradeep Kumar Patel. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner for the offence punishable under sections 318(4), 316(2) and 303(2) of BNS, 2023 and 7 Essential Commodities Act . Main allegation against the petitioner is that after cancellation of his licence of PDS shop , he didn't transfer the undistributed grains to the affiliated vendor.</p> <p>On perusal of para no. 16 of case dairy it prima facie revels that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He also undertakes to transfer the</p>

undistributed grains to the affiliated vendor. The petitioner is in judicial custody since **08.02.2026**. Moreover charge sheet has been submitted in the case so there is less chance tempering with the evidence.

Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and lack of criminal antecedent of the petitioners and period of incarceration , the prayer for bail of the petitioners **stands allowed**.

Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith. O/C is directed to deposit the record as per rules.
