Case no. 61/2026, registered u/s 115(2), 126(2), 109, 74, 3(5) of BNS 2023.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Birendra Kumar Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to previous enmity and grudge. He further submits that the accused are in custody from 13.02.2026. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections 115(2), 126(2), 109, 74, 3(5) of BNS 2023. Hence the instant bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Kajal Kumari. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and two others for the offence punishable under sections 115(2), 126(2), 109, 74, 3(5) of BNS 2023.</p> <p>On perusal of para no. 39 and 40 of the case dairy, It prima facie revels that injuries are simple in nature.
