Case no. 538/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Both case are disposed off with this common order for convenience.</p> <p>Sri Krishna Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused petitioner appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and has not committed any offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. He further submits that there is land dispute between both the parties. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, 2023. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Bimal Bind . NCCT Report shows that NO SIGNIFICANT ABNORMALITY IS SEEN in BRAIN PARENCHYMA. The petitioners are women and there is admitted land dispute as FIR itself.</p> <p>Considering the above enumerated facts and circumstances, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed.</p> <p>Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld.
